

His first formance was at 11 years old at the Palais Theatre in St. Kilda th the 1980 Gang Show. With a strong influence in theatre, he has rformed with Dandenong Light Opera Company and Cheltenham ght Opera Company from 1985 to 1994 in various musicals; cousel - Enoch Snow Jnr.; The Sound Of Music - Ralph; George and many others. Also with an exposure to television, including Playwright a few short character roles in Neighbours, Flying Doctors; and has

been involved in short films, training videos and commercials. He has now turned his hand to script writing for the stage and has studied film script writing with the Australian Film, Television & Radio School, Darren's latest script has been written over a number of years, taking much care to portray his message carefully. Without seeming cliche or contrived. While travelling through Queensland and Adelaide this story was formed through experiences he had witnessed and became involved with.
